CHARTERED CAMPS

It was noted that two camps closed, their charters recalled (Stewart Hope Camp and Admiral Worden Camp). Location of Charters unknown. Other camp properties to be turned in.

A new camp was chartered the Richard J. Clarke Camp #110 of Nassau, Suffolk, NY. Charter to be delivered.

IRS FILINGS

A reminder was made by Sec. Pugsley, PDC that Camps must file 990s and Form 30s to Dept.

- Camps will need to be suspended if their 990s are not filed with the IRS
- The IRS filing must be done by May 15th.(30 days after)
- Currently, there are up to 10 camps who have not met that obligation.
- Camps are instructed to print two copies of the filing one for camp commander, one for secretary/treasurer.
- Username and password should be held by two officers so they are never lost.
- Bro. Sec. Pugsley, PDC offered to maintain a partial list of some passwords and usernames for camps for IRS 990s.

CAMP REPORTS

Bro. Sec. Pugsley, PDC, noted that Camps submitted a low number of camp reports. More Camps should try to submit camp reports along with their standard camp reporting forms detailing their actions throughout the term as it gives a time capsule of history of that camp for that term.

FINANCES

A budget was proposed and accepted which was over \$152.00 and with a budget line item of \$200.00 for a new camp website, and operations priceline increased for costs of PDC Badges.

The Department has \$12,889.13 in our checking account.

DISCUSSION

Suggestion was made for the Dept to maintain a new email list of Brothers for registration for department news. Which would be sent electronically through an email service, like MailChimp. Such a email registration list could be made but dependent upon brothers registering on website.

It was suggested by Bro. Wheeler, PCinC, to appoint a one-day encampment study committee. It was amended to read that the committee shall be made up of one member each of the Dept allied orders and it was passed.

It was noted that the Ellis Camp offered a Scholarship Prize Program in the form of a Essay Contest. Additionally it was noted that the order needs more ways of reaching out to and serving the community as a 501c.

NATIONAL ENCAMPMENT FEASIBILITY COMMITTEE

The committee concluded that the National Encampment Feasibility Committee would most likely not recommend a National Encampment in New York next year. As such, they recommended that we give up this attempt. It was voted upon and decided to stop pursuing this year for the time being (11 for continuing a bid for next year, the rest against in favor of not pursuing this year).

MONUMENTS AND MEMORIALS COMMITTEE

Reported that there were no applications for grants and it was recommended by the Dept. Memorials Officer and Cmte that the grant protocol process be more prominently displayed on Dept. website. Work continues on the Dept memorials registered in the hopes of getting database in future on Dept website for all to see.

RALLY AROUND THE FLAG COMMITTEE

An Albany County trial run of mailing to local cities and towns for them to sponsor their local regimental flags for flag restoration would begin. It was recommended that the Flag database be placed on Dept website and it was agreed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A deed of gift agreement that was not signed between the Dept, under former Dept. Commander LeMay, and The NYS Military Museum was brought up by PDC LeMay. The deed was signed off on by Dept. Commander Verstreate and will be mailed to the Museum by PDC LeMay after much discussion.
