Department Order No. 7, Series 2019-2020

By the authority vested in me as Commander of the Department of New York, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, I hereby suspend the Col. John B. Weber Camp #44 Department of New York, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War for failure to submit their reports on time as of April 30, 2020.

This is done in accordance with By-Laws of Department of New York, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, Article XI Reports, Section 5 and the National Constitution & Regulations of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, Chapter 1 Camps, Article 1, Charters, Sections 8 which reads; "A Camp failing to pay their per capita dues or neglecting to forward reports within the time specified by law may be suspended by the Department Commander. Suspended Camps may be reinstated by forwarding reports and paying all arrearages of per capita dues."

Camps under suspension are only allowed to conduct business dealing with completion of items to bring their Charter active and are HIGHLY encouraged to do so, in an effort to be involved with events relating to Memorial Day.
