The scholarship is \$500.00 and is awarded each Memorial Day to the high school senior who demonstrates high academic achievement, a record of performance in school and community activities, an interest in the heritage of the United States, a letter of recommendation from either a school counselor, teacher or a responsible person in the community and a 500-word essay on a topic selected annually by the Department of New York SUVCW. All applications, essays and recommendations must be postmarked no later than and mailed to the address listed on the enclosed application. The winner will be announced on Memorial Day and notified by mail with a copy to the school. All submissions shall become the property of the SUVCW, Department of New York.

*The Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War is heir to the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) and is a fraternal, patriotic, and educational organization chartered by Act of Congress (Title 36 U.S.C. sections 200301 et seq.) and is made up of males who are descendants of soldiers, sailors or members of the Revenue Cutter Service who honorably served the Union during the American Civil War. The GAR was a veterans organization made up of veterans of the Union army, navy and revenue cutter service and founded Decoration Day, now known as Memorial Day.
