UNION DEFENDER'S DAY

In accordance with the motions adopted in 1889 at the 8th National Encampment of the SUVCW in Patterson, NJ, I reaffirm February 12th, Abraham Lincoln's Birthday, as Union Defender's Day in the Department of New York.
