SUMMARY OF 139TH NY DEPARTMENT ENCAMPMENT

Congratulations to all the elected and appointed officers in the NY department.

The following is a summary of the 139th Department Encampment held on 13-14 May 2022 IAW Article XI Section 2.

Department Secretary Summary is we have 507 members which include 45 Life members, 13 Juniors and one Honorary. Excluding dual members; we have 478 members. Last year total was 512 members. We gained 43 members and lost 48 members in this reporting period. We have 17 camps, no Real Sons, and no brothers assigned to a war zone.

Department Treasurer summary is as o 14 May 2022 the Department operating checking account balance after paying per capita to National is \$25,582.84, Savings Account balance is \$14,317.29 of which \$9,500.00 is set aside for the Department Memorial and Monument's Fund. The one-year renewable CD balance is \$10,807.53, The Permanent CD Fund balance is \$1,737.36. The Northwestern Mutual – Mutual Fund balance is \$12,257.62.
