**ANNUAL SUBMISSIONS OF REPORTS, RESOLUTIONS, & BYLAW
CHANGES REVISION 1**

1. In Accordance NY Department Bylaws Article XI, Section 7. “Annual Reports to the Encampment of Department Officers, Committee Chairs, and Camp Commanders which are submitted to the Department Commander and the Department Secretary shall be due three weeks prior to the Encampment. When submitting, email copies must be sent to all Department Officers and Camp Commanders.” **These reports are due NO LATER THAN 13 February 2026.**
2. In Accordance NY Department Bylaws, Article XVI, Section 1. “Alterations, amendments, or deletions to these By-Laws shall be made only at a regular session of Department Encampment, and by a two-thirds vote of the voting members present. All proposed alterations, amendments or deletions to the bylaws must be received either in writing or electronically by the Department Secretary and Department Commander no later than 60 days prior to the Encampment and shall thereafter be published on the Department website as soon as practicable but not later than 10 days prior to the Encampment. Alterations, amendments, or deletions received less than 60 days prior to said Encampment cannot be considered until the next succeeding Encampment.

The 60-day notice requirement may be waived at the Department Encampment upon two-thirds vote of those voting members present and entitled to vote.”

All Bylaw changes will be submitted NO LATER THAN 10 February 2026.

- 3. All Resolutions will also be submitted NO LATER THAN 10 February 2026.** The Department needs time for the Committees to review these with their recommendations and for the Department Secretary to have copies available at the Encampment.
